True recognises you are the primary educator of your child/ren. True supports parents/carers (and schools) through education sessions designed to supplement family conversations and aimed at encouraging parent/carer-child communication.

You have the opportunity to engage your child in conversation before True delivers out *All School* program at your child/s school.
