Support for Chaplaincy

The school are currently funded for a Chaplain. BSS are now able to apply for either a Chaplain or a student wellbeing officer. BSS have always had a Chaplain but can change to a student wellbeing officer and change application for funding. The School is required to consult with the community about the decision and minute the decision. The turnaround fairly soon. Applications open Friday 29th July. Questions about the qualifications of both a Chaplain and a Student Wellbeing officer. This person must not be involved in providing religious counselling or instruction, however a person who is a chaplain or student wellbeing officer may also be a Religious instructor provided that the religious instruction is delivered outside their normal Chaplaincy/Student wellbeing work hours.

Information about qualification not available. PCYC would recruit a Student Wellbeing Officer Scripture Union would recruit a Chaplain. So far Bulimba State school has been unable to successfully recruit a Chaplain.

Question regarding a psychologist. Answer – different funding for this. It can be used for a guidance officer or psychologist. The school is already using their funding.

This (chaplain/student wellbeing) funding is federally funded. There is state top up that Bulimba does not qualify for.

The community has to be consulted on either continuing with Chaplaincy or changing to a student Minimum qualification is Cert IV in Youth work. Also hold or working towards Diploma of Youth work or higher qualification in a relevant field. This is for both Chaplain or Student Wellbeing Officer. The program has been expanded to allow schools to choose. Comment from member: There is a presumption that the counselling provided is religious in nature from a chaplain when the job description requires that it is non-theological. Question about what the consultation look like? No Guidelines – able to show consultation has occurred. Can it go in the newsletter. It can be added to the next meeting agenda for discussion.
